POLICY FOR FYUGP SPOT ADMISSIONS, 2025-26 (REVISED)

Spot Admissions for applicants to the Faculties of Arts and Humanities/ Natural Sciences/ Social Sciences/ Commercial Studies and Computer Sciences under FYUGP 2025-26, for non-CUET candidates through the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (SAMARTH), will take place on 20th, 21st, 23rd and 24th June, 2025 (subject to the availability of seats) in the main campus of J.B. College according to the revised timeline issued by the office of the DHE, Govt. of Assam.

- All eligible candidates must assemble in the Admission venue and submit necessary documents to representatives of the respective departments of their choice for verification prior to the start of the admission process.

Venue: Gunagobinda Dutta Auditorium (Arts); Room B-101 (Science & BCA)
Commerce Department (Commerce)

- Collection and verification of documents will be done from at 9:30 am to 11:30 am on all days of the Spot Admission subject to the availability of seats. No applications will be entertained for the day after 11:30 am.
- Admission against available seats will begin at 12:00 noon and continue till 3:30 pm.
- This procedure will be followed by the departments until their respective non-CUET vacancies are filled up.
- The following documents (hardcopies) must be submitted for verification at the time of admission:
 - i) A printout of the completed SAMARTH form
 - ii) Original Mark Sheets (Digilocker printouts signed by the Principal of the institute last attended will be accepted)
 - iii) Original Caste Certificate.
- For Fee Waiver benefit, original Ration Card must be produced and a photocopy of the same submitted.
- Applicants without Ration Card must submit an original Income Certificate issued by Circle Officer and also a Declaration that neither of the parents (mother or father) is an employee of any State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government or Public Sector undertaking.
- Selection for Spot admission will be done as per Merit Criteria previously notified through the J.B. College Prospectus 2025-26 as well as the J.B. College website.
- Vacancies may not exist on all the dates specified above. Applicants are advised to check for available vacancies in the relevant departments on <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/> before coming for admission.
- The departments of Chemistry, English, Geography, Physics, Political Science and Sociology will give preference to candidates who have already appeared in their respective Major Selection Tests held in May, 2025.
- Applications for Reserved seats against the following Quota categories must be submitted to the Vice Principal, J.B. College:
 - Sports: 1 per stream; Culture: 1 per stream; NCC: 1 per stream
 - TGL (Fringe): 2 per stream; Employee: 1 per stream
- For applicants against Sports/Culture categories, minimum state level certificates will be accepted.
