RESERVATION AND RELAXATION RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES AND POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES UNDER JAGANNATH BAROOAH COLLEGE

The college shall follow the Reservation Policy/Rules as made and declared by the government for time to time for admission in to different programmes offered by the college.

(I) Statutory Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (S.C.) Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.) Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.) Other Backward Classes (O.B.C./ M.O.B.C.)	7%
	10% 5% 15%

Note: Caste Certificates must be issued by the competent authorities and countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the District concerned. Except statutory reservations, other kinds of reservations are not applicable for research programmes, viz. Ph.D.

(II) Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs):

10% seats are reserved for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in all the Academic Programmes. These seats shall be over and above the total intake capacity of the unreserved seats in each Academic Programme.

Note: To avail the benefit of the EWSs reservation the applicants must have to produce EWSs certificate issued by the competent authorities.

(III) Differently-abled (DA):

3% of the total seats in all the Academic Programmes are reserved for the differentlyabled students/persons with benchmark disabilities. Candidates applying for consideration under this category must submit Medical Certificate issued by the by the competent authorities

Sports:

Three (3) seats are reserved in this category with one (1) seat each for Four Year Under Graduate Programmes offered by the three streams. The three (03) seats created on supernumerary basis as stated above are non-transferrable to other categories, but will be interchangeable within the Academic Programmes.

Eligibility: Must have represented India/State (Assam) in any of the Olympic disciplines or Cricket conducted by the Associations/National Sports Federation/ State Sports Associations as recognized by the Sports Authority of India (SAI)/Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. Participation in the above-mentioned games and sports must not be earlier

than three years before the academic session in which admission is sought. Overall academic merit will be taken in to account for making the final selection.

(IV) Cultural:

Three (3) seats are reserved in this category with one (1) seat each for Four Year Under Graduate Programmes offered by the three streams. The three (03) seats created on supernumerary basis as stated above are non-transferrable to other categories, but will be interchangeable within the Academic Programmes.

Eligibility: Candidates need to have received recognition for their cultural talent, which can include awards, fellowships, or certifications from organizations recognized by Ministry of Cultural Affairs, Government of Assam/ Ministry of Culture, Government of India or any other Universities recognized and affiliated to University Grants Commission. Overall academic merit will be taken in to account for making the final selection.

(V) N.C.C.:

Three (3) seats are reserved in this category with one (1) seat each for Four Year Under Graduate Programmes offered by the three streams. The three (03) seats created on supernumerary basis as stated above are non-transferrable to other categories, but will be interchangeable within the Academic Programmes.

Eligibility: Applicants in this category must have to possess N. C. C. A, B or C Certificate issued by the Government of India. Preference will be given to the holder of the highest certificate. Overall academic merit will be taken in to account for making the final selection.

(VI) Tea Garden Labour (TGL):

Three (3) seats are reserved in this category with one (1) seat each for Four Year Under Graduate Programmes offered by the three streams. The three (03) seats created on supernumerary basis as stated above are non-transferrable to other categories, but will be interchangeable within the Academic Programmes.

Eligibility: Applicants in this category must have to produce TGL certificate issued by the concerned department, Government of Assam. Overall academic merit will be taken in to account for making the final selection.

(VII) Reservation for Sons and Daughters of Jagannath Barooah College Employees for Admission into the Academic Programmes:

A total of not more than three (3) seats are reserved for sons and daughters of the employees of Jagannath Barooah College working/retired in the regular posts for admission into Post Graduate and Four Year Under Graduate Programmes. Out of these three (3) seats two (2) are reserved for the Four Year Under Graduate Programmes and one (1) is reserved for the Post Graduate Programmes. The three (03) seats created on supernumerary basis as stated above are non-transferrable to other categories, but will be interchangeable within the Academic Programmes.
