- I. The Quotations will be opened by the Committee for SITA, J.B. College, Jorhat in presence of bidder's representative, if available. Only one representative will be allowed to participate in the tender opening. In the event of the due date of receipt and opening of the tender being declared as a holiday for the University, then the due date of receipt/opening of tender will be the next working day at the same time.
- II. The bidder should submit their hard copies of the tender documents only through registered post/by hand in the tender deposit box. The sealed envelopes should be clearly indicating "QUOTATIONS for "Supply of Books for J. B. College Civil Services Study Center".
- III. NO BID DOCUMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED BY EMAIL.
- IV. The Firm should sign at the bottom space of all pages of document.
- V. Trade license, GST return certificate and PAN along with the address proof to be enclosed by the bidders.
- VI. The books must be supplied within stipulated date and time of placing orders.
- VII. Only latest editions are to be supplied and these should not be remainder titles.
- VIII. The vendor should be one of the members of the Federation of Publishers' and Booksellers' Association in India (FPBAI) or Assam State Booksellers' and Publishers' Association. Attachment of the document in support is mandatory.

- XI. The bidder should furnish attested copies of all the documents.
- XII. The tender document shall be submitted in two parts as follows:
aPART-1: This packet shall contain the Technical Bids comprising NIQ, testimonials, other supporting documents, and any other relevant document the tenderer wish to submit duly signed with official seal etc. This shall be marked as 'TECHNICAL BID', followed by the short NIT number and name of the work and properly sealed. The bid security to be put inside the 'TECHNICAL BID' in a separate sealed envelope.
bPART-2: This packet shall contain the Price Bids comprising the price against the tender. This shall be marked as 'FINANCIAL BID', followed by the short NIQ number and name of the work and properly sealed.
- XIII. **Quoting price for each item listed in the ANNEXURE-1 is mandatory in the FINANCIAL BID and failing to which the Price Bid shall be rejected.**
- XIV. The Technical Bid shall be opened first on the above-mentioned date and time and the Financial Bid of only those bidders who qualify in Technical Bid shall be opened on the same date. Tenderer or their authorized representative should be present at the time of opening of the tenders along with original documents submitted with the technical bid. Absentee's queries will not be entertained.
- XV. The vendor should offer a maximum discount on published/printed prices for all books in English/Hindi/other languages of Indian or foreign origin.
- XVI. The rate should be inclusive of all applicable taxes and on DOOR DELIVERY J.B. College basis.
- XVII. In the case of foreign publication(s), the original prices in the foreign currency should be mentioned in the invoice(s) along with the prices in rupees charged as per the Good Office Committee (GOC).
- XVIII. Documents submitted should be legible.
- XIX. If for any reason the last date of issuing/submitted tender papers is a declared holiday/bandh, tenders will be issues/received/opened on the next working day.
- XX. The undersigned will be the sole authority to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
