<b>1 BOTANY &amp; ZOOLOGY</b>	At least 60% marks in <b>Biology</b> , 55% in <b>Chemistry</b> and 45% in <b>English</b> in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in <b>Physics, Chemistry</b> and <b>Biology</b> in 10+2 Exam plus marks secured in <b>Biology</b> .
<b>2 CHEMISTRY</b>	At least 60% marks in <b>Chemistry</b> and 40% marks in <b>Mathematics</b> in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in <b>Physics, Chemistry</b> and <b>Mathematics</b> in 10+2 Exam plus marks secured in <b>Chemistry</b> .
<b>3 PHYSICS</b>	At least 60% marks in <b>Physics</b> and 40% marks in <b>Mathematics</b> in 10+2 Examination
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in <b>Physics, Chemistry</b> and <b>Mathematics</b> in 10+2 Exam plus marks secured in <b>Physics</b> .
<b>4 GEOLOGY</b>	Must pass in <b>Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics</b> in 10+2 examination with total of 170 marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (Relaxation of 10 marks for students with Geology as subject in 10+2 exam).
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination.
<b>5 MATHEMATICS</b>	At least 45% marks in Mathematics in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in <b>Physics, Chemistry</b> and <b>Mathematics/Economics, Statistics</b> and <b>Mathematics</b> in 10+2 Examination <b>Plus</b> marks obtained in <b>Mathematics</b> .
<b>6 STATISTICS</b>	At least 40% marks in Mathematics in 10+2 Examination. However, 5% relaxation in Mathematics will be allowed to those with <b>Statistics</b> in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination

<b>7 ELECTRONIC SCIENCE</b>	Must pass in <b>Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics</b> in 10+2 examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination
