1. Rate should be quoted in flat percentage basis i.e., above/below/at per CPWD DSR(Civil) for the year 2021; considering all the taxes, duties and other levies as per Govt. rule and the same will be deducted from the bill as per the prevailing rules.
2. The bidders should submit self-attested copies of up-to-date, valid registration certificate from APWD/CPWD; Labour licence; PAN Card; GST return; EPF registration; Caste certificate (if any); Work orders with certificates of completion of similar nature of works during the last 5 years.
3. The participating contractors shall have to possess their own technically qualified and experienced team for accurate implementation of the proposed work at the site location to be provided by the undersigned from time to time.
4. Successful bidder has to start the work within 2 days from the date of issue of work order. No extension of time will be allowed and Earnest money deposited will be forfeited if the successful bidder dis-honours the work-order or fail to complete the work within the stipulated time.
5. Acceptance of the lowest bidder is not mandatory on the Building/Construction Committee, J.B. University, Jorhat and its decision will be final and binding on all parties.
