

NOTICE FOR UG 2nd SEMESTER STUDENTS UNDER FYUGP

This is to notify the all 2nd semester UG students (under FYUGP of NEP 2020) of J. B. College, Jorhat that they will have to study different **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)** and **Multidisciplinary courses** in 2nd semester. For that, students will have to apply for the course(s) in which she/he wants to enroll in the 2nd semester. As the number of seats in each department is limited, allocation of seats will be solely on “first-come-first-served” basis.

Students are advised to keep their options open and submit applications in person to the departments of their choice. They may be redirected to other departments of their choice when seats are filled up in a particular department,

Applications must be submitted between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm till 7th February, 2026. No application will be entertained on any account after this date.

Selection of Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)

For SEC there will two options for the students from this year. Students will have to select any one of them and complete the course accordingly -

- A. Course offered by different departments of the college, and**
- B. Course offered by SWAYAM online platform.**

A. Students opting for the courses offered by the college may select any subject from the given list, provided the student has not studied the SEC subject in their 1st semester.

N.B.: Students opting for SWAYAM courses must note the following points:

- Courses are designed and curated by faculty from top Higher Education Institutions of India
- Course completion certificates obtained from SWAYAM will be treated at par with existing SEC course under J.B. College
- All courses will be of 3 credits.
- Enrolled students will be required to submit (online) weekly assignments.
- Failure to submit assignments will render the student unable to sit for the End Semester examination
- Students will be eligible for a certificate only if their Average Score $\geq 10/25$ and Exam Score $\geq 30/75$.
- End Semester (online) examination for SWAYAM courses will be held at designated Test Centers in Dibrugarh and Tezpur
- There will be an Exam Fee of ₹1000/- to be paid at the time of final registration.

- Students from **Arts** will study a course from **Social Science and Humanities**
- Students from **Commerce** will study a course from **Natural and Physical Science and Library Science**

- Students from **Science** will study a course from **Commerce, Statistics & Computer Science**.
