**ELECTION NOTIFICATION
JAGANNATH BAROOAH UNIVERSITY STUDENTS' UNION ELECTION 2025-26**

This is for the information of all concerned that the Jagannath Barooah University Students' Union Election, 2025-26 will be held on 30/01/2026.

1. Nomination papers will be issued from the Office of the Registrar on 20/01/2026 (from 11 am to 1 pm) on payment of Rs. 200/- per paper (in cash). No nomination paper will be issued after 1 pm.
2. Photo copy of Mark sheet of previous semesters should be submitted along with nomination paper. Candidates should submit a certificate of appearing in-semester examination of the current session from the concerned Head of the Department.
3. Only University Regular students will be eligible for contesting in the election and they will have to furnish a certificate from the JBU authority to this effect. **Further, a certificate of good conduct issued by the Joint Coordinators (signatures of both the coordinators are mandatory) of the Disciplinary Committee of the University shall have to be enclosed along with the nomination paper.**
4. The candidate must submit duly filled up nomination paper on 22/01/2026 (from 11 am to 2 pm) and no nomination will be accepted after expiry of stipulated time and date under any Circumstances.
5. Nominations are to be submitted to the Returning Officer at the Office of the Registrar in sealed cover stating clearly the name of the candidate and the portfolio.
6. Nomination papers will be scrutinized at 2.10 pm on 22/01/2026 by the Returning Officer. The list of eligible candidates will be notified in the University notice board after the completion of scrutiny on the same day.
7. The last date of withdrawal of nomination is fixed at 10 A.M to 12 noon on 24/01/2026. Final list of qualified candidates will be displayed at 2 pm on the same day on University Notice Board.
8. The displaying of posters related to the election within the premises (Main Gate to Borpatra Kutir) of the University will be allowed from 12 Noon to 3 P.M only on 28/01/2026.
9. Stage Campaign of the candidates will be held from 11 A.M to 2 P.M on 28/01/26.
10. Wall pasting of banner and poster in the campus is strictly prohibited.
11. The campaigning and displaying of poster for the election will come to an end on 28/01/2026 at 3 pm. In no circumstances election related campaign and display of posters will be allowed after 3 pm (28/01/2026). **University gate will open at 8.00 am on 30/01/2026 for the students to cast their votes.**

12. Pasting of banners and pamphlets regarding student union election are strictly prohibited after 3 pm before the day of election.
13. Entering into University premise before 8 am on the day of election will automatically lead to disciplinary action.
14. In any circumstances students are not allowed to stay at the University campus after 3 pm on 29/01/2026.
15. **In any circumstances no election related campaigning is allowed in the J.B. University hostels after 6 pm during the notified dates of campaigning. Further, visitors are not allowed to visit and stay in the J.B. University hostels on 28/01/2026 and 29/01/2026.**
16. Only regular students of 2nd semester Post Graduate (Regular Courses) will be eligible to contest for the portfolio of President. Only Post Graduate 2nd semester regular students will be eligible to contest for the portfolio of Vice-President. In no circumstances they are eligible to contest in other portfolios other than stated above.
17. Only students of UG (4th and 6th) semester are eligible for the portfolio of General Secretary.
18. Only students of UG (2nd and 4th) semester are eligible for the portfolio of Magazine Secretary.
19. Eligible candidate will have to sign a prescribed bond/undertaking containing rules and regulations of election along with nomination papers.
20. Time of voting on 30/01/2026 is from 9 am to 1 pm.
21. The voters will be allowed to cast their votes only after production of their duly signed Identity Cards (hard copy) /Admission Receipts issued by the University authority.
Students who fail to come with prescribed University uniform will not be allowed to cast their votes.
22. If a candidate was previously been convicted by the University Disciplinary Committee, then he/she is not eligible to contest in the election.
23. Counting of votes will start from 2 pm on 30/01/2026.
24. Election results will be declared on 30/01/2026 after completion of counting of votes.
25. The Screening committee decision is the last and final for the nomination paper cancellation.
26. **The guidelines for candidates as per Honorable Supreme Court's Order:**

- a) Under Graduate students between the age of 17 to 22 years and post graduate students with maximum age limit be between 24-25 years may contest in the election.
- b) The candidates should not have any academic arrears against his/her name in any End Semester Examination.
- c) The candidates shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer during his/her tenure as a student of Jagannath Barooah University, Jorhat.
- d) The candidates, proposers and supporters should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University, i.e., 80% attendance.
- e) The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall not exceed Rs. 5000/- (Five thousand).
- f) Each candidate shall within two weeks, of the declaration of the results submit complete audited accounts of his/her election expenditure to the University authority and the same shall be displayed in university notice board. The election of the candidate stands nullified failing to adhere to this procedure.
- g) Candidates are only allowed to utilize handmade posters at duly notified places of the University campus by the Returning Officer.
- h) No candidate shall be permitted to canvass outside the University campus.
- i) Candidatures of the contesting candidates shall be cancelled if he/she uses any unparliamentarily words regarding caste/ creed/ sex/ religion/ nation during the election campaign.

- j) All candidates shall be jointly responsible for ensuring the cleaning up of the polling area immediately on conclusion of polling.
