Full Paper: The full paper should not exceed 4000 words. font size 12, Times New Roman, Line Spacing: 1.5, Justified aligned. The paper must follow MLA or APA reference style. The paper should contain a suitable title, author's name, designation, affiliation and E-mail ID.
