ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Geology, Jagannath Barooah College was constituted in 1977. Two academic members were involved in the department's founding: S.K. Bhagawati and Mukut Bora, the department's founder head. Later, in 1981, the department began offering geology classes in higher secondary education. The department began offering a full-fledged B.Sc. major in geology in 1984. The department currently provides a B.Sc. (Honors) in Geology academic program. The department's main goal is to comprehend the basic ideas behind Earth and planetary systems. Its B.Sc. program accepts roughly 40 students a year. There are now five faculty members and one office staff member in the department. It can conduct its teaching-learning activities in a large number of contemporary classrooms and laboratories. A respectable assortment of books and magazines can be found in the departmental library.

In addition, the faculty members of the department carry out research in diverse fields. To obtain a better knowledge of the subject, the faculty of the department planned a Field School as part of a Skill Enhancement Course.

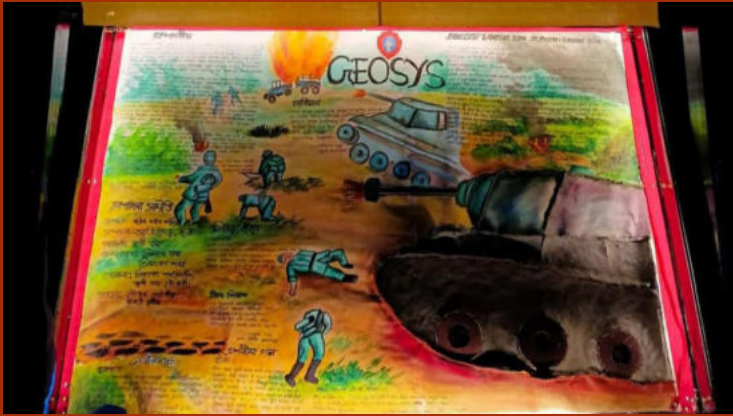

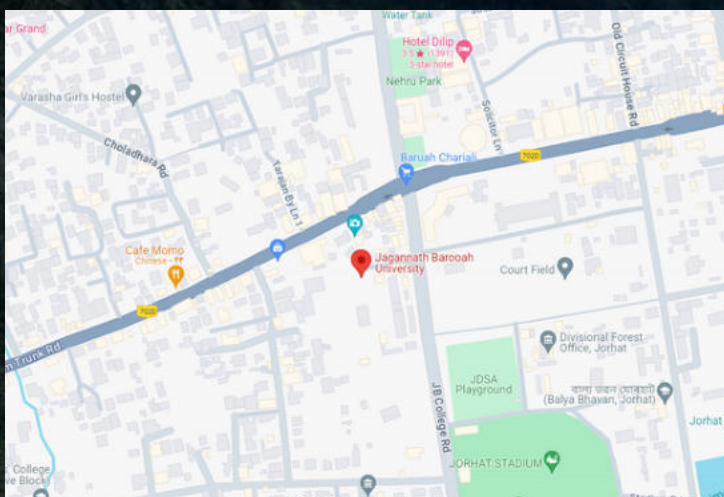
DEPARTMENT OF GEOLOGY
